Proposal to Parish Council:

- 1. The following people will be trained as Liturgical Assistants who can lead the congregation in worship using Service of the Word: Michael Perkin, Janis Perkin, Jenny Morphew, David Matthews, Sheila Vaudrey, Sheila Pitt, Keith Wilkins, and Ministry Intern Nash Smith.
- 2. Brenda Zanin will also invited be to take part when she returns from vacation.
- 3. Purpose:
 - a. explore a ministry opportunity that uses gifts present in our community and emphasizes the ministry of the whole people of God
 - b. be prepared for unexpected circumstances
- 4. Training will take place at the 10 am service once per month, beginning in March with Nash Smith so that he can take part before his internship ends at Easter.
- 5. Booklets with the service printed in full will be used.
- 6. On these Sundays, the order of service will include the liturgy approved by General Synod called *Service of the Word* up to and including the offertory. Fr Brian will deliver the sermon. While normally, this service stands on its own, Fr Brian will celebrate Holy Communion as well, at the end.
- 7. Eventually, it will be possible to take the regularly planned order of service and switch at the last minute to this one.
- 8. We might consider this service as an option in the summer, with or without clergy to do communion.
- 9. This is not meant to include preaching. Should someone wish to explore becoming a Lay Reader, there is separate training available and a process to affirm that person's ministry in the parish.
