A Note from the COVID Communiqué

"We are keeping our eyes on infection rates across our diocese, and will alert you if increased restrictions are required this fall. ... At this point, we are not requiring that all worshippers be double-vaccinated. However for certain roles—such as singing in the choir, or administering communion—every eligible person who has no medical condition preventing vaccination should be fully vaccinated before they participate in liturgies (and, in the case of choristers, rehearsals)."
