In-person 10 am Services Start Feb 6

With the province beginning to open up, the Diocese is allowing us to resume in-person worship services cautiously. Here is how we will proceed:

- The 10 am service will resume on Sunday February 6. A date for the resumption of the 8 am service has not been set yet.
- Pre-register by phone (613-224-7431) or by email (<u>stmarks@stmarksottawa.ca</u>) due to a capacity limit
- Anyone with COVID symptoms should assume that they have the virus and stay home
- Provide proof of double vaccination, if you have not shown it to us before. Booster shots are strongly encouraged.
- Masks must be worn when you enter the building and throughout the service, except when taking communion. Three-layer, medical or N95 masks are encouraged

- Physical distancing (except for members of the same household) must be maintained at all times
- No congregational singing is permitted

• Leave the church promptly after the service We anticipate further loosening of our diocesan COVID protocols in the coming weeks. Consult the St Mark's website (www.stmarksottawa.ca) for updates. Livestreaming of our 10 a.m. service will continue to be offered every week.
