Worship is the foundation of all faith communities. While worship is not the only focus of a faith community, it is a consistent and comforting way of praising the Lord and gathering in community. In the Anglican tradition, music has a long association with worship, enhancing and reinforcing the service's focus. Starting during the pandemic, St. Mark's has extended its worship into the virtual world, first by recorded videos and later by live stream technology. Through our in-person and virtual worship and music, we make an impact.

COVID Status

In his most recent communique, our Bishop announced a revision of the Diocesan COVID restrictions. Parishes can now observe normal social and liturgical practices, with one exception, while following the three main public health recommendations. These are:

- asking people to stay home when sick;
- encouraging mask-wearing in indoor spaces; and
- keeping up-to-date on COVID boosters.

The one liturgical exception to normal practices is that LAC's must wear masks when administering communion.
