As was announced last Sunday, Fr Julian's last day at St. Mark's will be January 12, 2025. Fr. Julian leaves to be the Rector of Good Shepherd Episcopal Church in Wichita, Kansas. As well, the Bishop of Kansas has

appointment him as the Co-Chair of the task force on Social Justice for the entire Episcopal Diocese of Kansas.

Latest Update on COVID 19

From now until October 28th, doses of the new COVID-19 vaccine are prioritized for high-risk and priority populations, which include adults 65 years of age and older. Starting October 28th, anyone 6 months and older can access the COVID-19 vaccine in Ontario. In the meantime, please keep using what OPH calls your layers of protection, which work for COVID-19 and other respiratory illnesses like influenza (flu) and RSV. These are:

- Stay home when you are sick
- Avoid visiting people at high risk when you are sick
- Consider wearing a mask to protect yourself, to protect others, or when recovering from illness.
